CBGS fund raising efforts eclipses the \$200,000 mark

CBGS announced payment to the City of Brentwood in the amount of \$13,740 at the October 26, 2017 Brentwood City Commission meeting. The funds were raised from the recent “A Walk in the Park” fundraiser and donor contributions. Remarked President Gil Hutchinson: “This presentation marks an important milestone in our organization's history. With this payment, a total of nearly \$210,000 has been paid project to date.”
